- ◆ **OPERATIONAL REMINDERS**
- ◆ Track maintenance includes cutting the grass. You will need to prep the track before racing starts, during intermission, and at the end of the night’s program. If in doubt, ask Paul Dice
- ◆ If your car is starting on the pole in the next race, you are the pit steward for that race. This means that you are responsible for checking that all the drivers in your race are properly buckled into their cars and have all their safety equipment on and adjusted properly.
- ◆ The next race should start lining up in the staging area as soon as all the cars in the current race are on the track.
- ◆ If you are a corner person you need to help line up the cars for a restart while under the yellow flag.
