• From the General Meeting

REMEMBER OUR CHANGE OF MEETING LOCATION – Famularo’s is where we held last year’s banquet. With the recent passing of long time member Craig Ford, the Club voted to name our July 31 race as the Craig Ford Memorial Race, with funds generated from that race donated to the American Cancer Society. The second \$100 portion of the assessment is due at the June 3 meeting. All members can use funds generated thru the race sponsor advertising brochure to cover all or part of this second assessment. Race night, billboard, web link, and banquet book advertising is available. Beth Dice is creating the racing work schedule, so if you will be on vacation please let her know so that she can schedule you on other days. Once the schedule is published, it is your job to be there when scheduled or find a substitute. We have a work switch form that both parties need to fill out so we know who is responsible on any given night. The back gate fees will be on a per item basis for all races except the Kenny Hein events. The rate will be \$5 per item for Club members. Fees will be higher for guests as part of the 6 event Open program.

- ◆ The Club picnic will be held on Sunday August 8, at Knoebels Amusement Park.
- ◆ August 21 is our Fun Night Race. Drivers should bring their painted ceramic cars for judging.
- ◆ **OPERATIONAL REMINDERS**
- ◆ Track maintenance includes cutting the grass. You will need to prep the track before racing starts, during intermission, and at the end of the night’s program. Track also includes putting the tractors away, picking up the cones and fire extinguishers and putting them away at the end of the night. If in doubt, ask Paul Dice.
- ◆ If your car is starting on the pole in the next race, you are the pit steward for that race. This means that you are responsible for checking that all the drivers in your race are properly buckled into their cars and have all their safety equipment on and adjusted properly. Also check the steering wheels and watch for the flagger to motion your race out onto the track. The next race should start lining up in the staging area as soon as all the cars in the current race are on the track.
- ◆ If you are a corner person you need to help line up the cars for a restart while under the yellow flag. Please listen to the judges and PA for the restart order. This will help the flagman and speed up the show.
- ◆ The first NASCAR race weekend is June 4 and 5. Please contact Janice about Pocono shifts if you have not done so already. If someone is covering your shift, they must be at least 18 years of age and we need their phone number.
