• From the General Meeting

REMEMBER OUR CHANGE OF MEETING LOCATION – Famularo’s is where we held last year’s banquet. We printed a limited quantity of tri-fold wallet schedules and the schedule will also appear in the AARN schedule pull out section. The 2010 Rule Book has been printed and each active member gets one copy. The Board would like to thank all those advertisers that stepped up to help defray the cost of printing. With the recent passing of long time member Craig Ford, the Club voted to name our July 31 race as the Craig Ford Memorial Race, with funds generated from that race donated to the American Cancer Society. The Board has approved a \$200 assessment per active member, the same as last year. Assessment Part I has been extended to the May meeting; you cannot race until it is paid. Assessment Part II. This second \$100 portion of the assessment is not due until the June 3 meeting. All members can use funds generated thru the race sponsor advertising brochure to cover all or part of this second assessment. Race night, billboard, web link, and banquet book advertising is available. Joe Carroll is creating the racing work schedule, so if you will be on vacation please let him know so that he can schedule you on other days. Once the schedule is published, it is your job to be there when scheduled or find a substitute. We have a work switch form that both parties need to fill out so we know who is responsible on any given night. The back gate fees will be on a per item basis for all races except the Kenny Hein events. The rate will be \$5 per item for Club members. Fees will be higher for guests as part of the 6 event Open program.

• From the Board Meeting

- ◆ 2500 TAQM flyers were handed out. Even in terrible weather conditions, we had 33 drivers try out cars for 27 families. The program generated several new members. Three companies sponsored 6 families for free: Rick’s Atech Automotive, Ken’s Auto Service Center, and Gasoline Alley – WALN Cable FM 92. Gil created TAQM certificates for all participating drivers.
- ◆ JPA Masonry has agreed to sponsor our July 10th race.
- ◆ **OPERATIONAL REMINDERS** There will be NO fueling in the pits or with the driver in the car. Each member must supply their own fuel, but NO fuel cans are allowed in the pits. If you start your car in the pits, on blocks, a car stand, or otherwise, do not leave your car unattended while it is running. Furthermore, a running car should be pointed towards the fence. Only members are allowed in the pits during the races.
- ◆ If you see a child doing something wrong, i.e. throwing rocks, please correct them. Even the best parents cannot be everywhere at once. There are no bikes, skateboards, footballs, etc permitted in the pits.
- ◆ All children, including drivers, are not permitted on the flag stand or to flag warm ups or races.
- ◆ If you have moved up a class, please turn in the restrictor plates you no longer need.
