- From the Board Meeting

- ◆ **2011 Awards Banquet**
- ◆ The banquet will be held at Famularo's on November 19.
- ◆ The doors will open at 5pm.
- ◆ Tickets are \$35 for adults, \$25 for children; a child under 5 is free.
- ◆ Each registered driver gets a banquet meal ticket as part of their banquet package.
- ◆ A \$30 ad is required for each driver for the banquet book. We are going with a simplified ad structure this year. There will be 2 ad sizes. A half page ad will be \$30 and a full page ad will be \$60. All members are encouraged to sell additional ads.
- ◆ All ads need to be turned in by the November 3 meeting.
- ◆ **ELECTION.** Nominations were opened at the October meeting and additional nominations will be accepted at the November meeting before the voting takes place. In order to run for a board position, you must be an active 2012 member and have attended 50% of the 2011 monthly general membership meetings. Only active members and lifetime graduate drivers are allowed to vote.
- ◆ **2012 Rules.** Any engine rule changes need to be proposed by the December meeting so that they can be voted on at the January meeting. All proposed rule changes, whether tech or procedure, should be written down and handed in to a board member. Your proposed rule change can be e-mailed to the Club as well.
